

1. Privacy

Privacy is a matter of trust and your trust is important to us. In order to feel safe when visiting our website, we strictly enforce the legal provisions when processing your personal data and we would like to inform you here about the collection of data and their use. The following privacy policy explains which of your data is collected on our website, which of these data we process and use and who you may contact for any relevant concerns.

We emphasize that the transmission of data on the Internet (eg in the case of e-mail communication) may have security gaps. Full data protection from third-party access is not possible.

2. The responsible body

The body responsible for the collection, processing and use of your personal data within the meaning of GDPR is AIEEx - AUSTRIAN INSTITUTE OF EXCELLENCE.

3. The right to appeal to the competent supervisory authority

In case of violation of data protection, data subjects have the right to appeal to the official, responsible for data protection of AIEEx, at mbrojtjatedhenave@aie.al

4. Collection and use of personal data

Personal data is information about the factual or personal circumstances of a particular or identifiable natural person. This includes, for example, name, phone number, mail address . If you visit our website or communicate with us, you can share information about yourself. This may also include data that allows conclusions about your person ("personal data").

5. Contact form

If you send us a request via the contact form, your contact details as well as further information on processing the request or subsequent questions will be saved by us.

We will not share this information without your consent. The processing of data entered in the contact form is based only on your consent (Article 6 paragraph 1. DSGVO).

You may revoke this consent at any time.

To do this, send an informal e-mail to mbrojtjatedhenave@aie.at. The legality of data processing operations performed up to revocation remains untouched by revocation.

The data provided by you on the contact form will be stored by us until you ask us to delete it, cancel your consent to the storage or the purpose of storing the data (eg upon completion of your request). Mandatory legal provisions - especially retention periods - remain intact.
